Notes:

1. These rates will be indexed at the start of each year and adjusted for inflation (CPI). Rates will be adjusted in 50c increments.
2. Referees are required to be current members of VACT as a player OR referee to be paid. VACT expects referees to have a current Working with Children Check.
3. When refereeing Beach Volleyball you will be required to rake the court at the completion of games on that court.
4. For CVL matches referees will be required to wear a current Volleyball Australia referee uniform or be neatly attired e.g. a polo shirt to be paid.
